## PROUDLY IN PARTNERSHIP

*with Champagne Laurent-Perrier*

Established in 1812, the house remains family-owned to this day, and Laurent-Perrier's Cellar Master, Michel Fauconnet, has been there for roughly 50 years. Bernard de Nonancourt took over the house at a mere 28 years old, having returned from fighting in the Second World War. The vision he set out for the house during his tenure remains his legacy. Today, it is his daughters Alexandra and Stephanie that oversee operations, following Bernard's death in 2010.

An obsession for quality and purity in the wines creates a style that is clean, easy-to-drink, with a refreshing elegance in the mouth. This is largely thanks to high quality Chardonnay grapes forming the backbone of the house's style, along with extended ageing of the bottles.

# CHAMPAGNE LAURENT-PERRIER

## *NV La Cuvee, Laurent Perrier, Champagne, France*

Fresh and textured, with lemon-sharp acidity, this has a high proportion of Chardonnay, giving it a lemon biscuit nose and a sherbet finish.

## *NV Cuvée Rosé, Laurent Perrier, Champagne, France*

A glorious sparkling rosé in an old-fashioned bottle that fizzes as much with fine acidity as with bubbles and fills the mouth with fragrant red fruit.

## *NV Blanc des Blancs Brut Nature, Laurent Perrier, Champagne, France*

Serious yet appealing Chardonnay-only zero-dosage Champagne, tasting of lemon, lime and a slash of minerality, with a faint perfume of flowers on the nose.

## *NV Heritage, Laurent Perrier, Champagne, France*

White gold colour with a fine and persistent effervescence. A nose offering notes of lemon, white peach and fruits in syrup, followed by aromas of toasted bread and toasted almonds. Fresh at first which gives way to a lively, elegant and complex palate with aromas of white fruits and citrus zest.

## *NV Brut Millésimé, Laurent Perrier, Champagne, France*

Elegant and refined with crisp citrus, ripe orchard fruit and delicate brioche notes, finishing long, fresh and beautifully balanced.

## *NV Grand Siècle, Iteration No.26, Laurent Perrier, Champagne, France*

Entirely from Grand Cru vineyards, using grapes from three complementary years, Grand Siècle is honeyed, nutty, creamy on the nose and fresh on the palate and lasts almost as long in the mouth as the drinker wishes it would.



# CHAMPAGNE AND SPARKLING

## *Prosecco Argeo NV Ruggeri, Veneto, Italy*

Delicate, zesty Prosecco, exuding green apples and citrus. A delightful Italian alternative to Champagne. This classic, sophisticated, apple flavoured sparkling wine is made in the Veneto, North East Italy from the Prosecco grape and is a delightful alternative to Champagne.

## *NV Sparkling Love by Léoube Organic Rosé, Chateau Léoube, Provence, France*

In a bottle adorned with hearts, this sparkling blend of Provencal grapes delights with red fruit aromas of pomegranate, berries, and grapefruit. Elegant bubbles and refreshing acidity complement its soft, rounded finish — a perfect choice for beautiful weddings

## *NV Cremant de Bourgogne Brut Grande Cuvee, Veuve Ambal Burgundy, France*

Burgundian fizz, full of exotic fruit, balanced by a fresh wash of citrus; on the nose, the perfume of white flowers and a warm scent of fresh-baked pastries.

## *Chateau Léoube Brut Sparkling Organic, Chateau Leoube, Provence, France*

A traditional method sparkling from Provence, made from Cabernet Franc grapes. Lively and fresh, with a beautiful translucent rosé petal colour. This Brut Nature sparkling has vibrant bubbles and delicate aromas of pink grapefruit and peach. With lovely golden brioche notes and mineral characters on the palate, leading to a round creamy finish.

## *NV Alliances Brut, Champagne A. Robert, Champagne, France*

A fresh, balanced and generous champagne, nice lively bubbles with a beautiful length. Elegant and delicate, Alliances N°16 opens on notes of mature yellow fruit and finishes on slightly roasted flavours. Appreciated for its spontaneity, the palate reveals an elegant and balanced maturity, that ends on a touch of candied citrus fruits.

## *Hattingley Classic Reserve, Hampshire, England*

Pure, sparkling English wine with a delicate perfume of hedgerow flowers, a flavour of green apples and a fine, rich toastiness on the finish. This is the perfect aperitif or celebration drink, it is the flawless accompaniment to any party, enjoyed with any canapé.

## *Hattingley Rose, Hampshire, England*

Pink grapefruit and sweet marshmallow on the palate, bring a balanced and highly drinkable quality to this English sparkling wine. With just a touch of oak ageing, it has a delightful creaminess, that effortlessly complements a variety of cuisines.



# WHITE WINE

## *Trebbiano IGT Rubicone, Rometta, Emiliano Romagna, Italy*

Charming expression of the Trebbiano grape, fragrant with white flowers, followed by a mouthful of juicy pear and white peach.

## *Pinot Grigio, Arco dei Givi, Veneto, Italy*

Bright straw-yellow colour with soft green reflections. On the nose it offers captivating floral aromas of chamomile and white pulp fruit. Elegant and delicate with a pleasant freshness.

## *Estate Sauvignon Blanc, De Martino, Casablanca Valley, Chile*

Intense aromas of ripe citrus and tropical fruit that lead to a fresh palate with medium body.

## *Picpoul de Pinet, Les Prades Languedoc-Roussillon, France*

A subtle, fresh white from this popular southern French grape offers a floral nose and refreshing lemon and tangy grapefruit on the palate.

## *Alba Albarino Martin, Martin Codax, Rias Baixas, Spain*

Vivid straw-yellow green colour. Intense nose and elegant aromas with hints of white stone fruits and white flowers. The proximity to the sea gives the wine its freshness, and the granitic soils enhance its natural minerality.

## *Love by Leoube Blanc Organic, Chateau Leoube, Provence, France*

Light and easy to drink, this organic white wine is made with traditional white grapes from Provence. Fresh and delicious, showing pleasing aromas of white fruits, fresh green apples, and ripe pineapples.

## *Macon-Villages Les Preludes, Vignerons des Terres Secretes Burgundy, France*

Nicely balanced Chardonnay from southern Burgundy, perfumed with white flowers, brimming with juicy yellow peach and finishing on a fine, refreshing mist of citrus.

## *La Segreta Grillo Organic Sicilia DOC, Planeta, Sicily, Italy*

Grillo is the rounded white variety indigenous to Sicily; this version is perfumed with citrus and juicy with white peach and tropical fruit.

## *Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc Rapaura Springs, Summerhouse Marlborough, New Zealand*

A riot of ripe citrus and tropical fruit aromas. Loaded with juicy rock melon, lychee, vibrant stone fruits and lemongrass, the mouth-watering finish on this one deserves some serious savouring

## *Gavi di Gavi, La Minaia, Nicola Bergaglio, Piemonte, Italy*

The thin-skinned Cortese grape that makes Piedmont's Gavi, releases aromas of acacia and white peach, tickles the nose with wild herb, then settles on the tongue in a swirl of apple, lemon and melon.

## *Old Vines Chenin, Ken Forrester, Stellenbosch, South Africa*

Golden hued and full bodied with melon and spicy baked apple aromas. Layered with mineral notes enhanced by honeycomb and caramel flavours.

## *Pomino Bianco, Frescobaldi, Toscana, Italy*

Clear and bright, this wine radiates like the sunny 2020 harvest at Castello Pomino. Floral aromas dominate, with honeysuckle prevailing. The bouquet lingers on the palate, a result of lees aging after vinification.

## *Sancerre Cuvée Insolite, Franck Millet, Loire, France*

An expressive combination of green fruit, fresh-cut grass and minerals on the nose, followed by a crisp mouthful of greengage, lime and gooseberry.



# RED WINE

## *Sangiovese IGT Rubicone, Rometta, Emiliano Romagna, Italy*

Spicy, berry-filled Sangiovese, perfumed with roses, violets and potpourri, followed by a mouthful of blackcurrants.

## *Puente de Salceda Crianza Rioja, Vina Salceda, Rioja, Spain*

Intense and lively cherry colour. Aromatically reminiscent of red fruits and sweet spices, very well combined with the fine notes of barrel ageing. In the mouth it is fresh, round, enveloping and the tannin is ripe.

## *Estate Merlot, De Martino, Maipo Valley, Chile*

Ripe dark and red berry fruit aromatics including blueberries and raspberries, combined with a plummy and spicy note.

## *Don David Malbec, El Esteco, Mendoza, Argentina*

Classic Argentinian Malbec, rich and filled with berries, plum jam, the fine, perfumed acidity of redcurrants, with the elegant scent of violets on the nose, plus the sweetness of vanilla and a hint of dark chocolate.

## *Côtes du Rhône Rouge, Domaine de la Janasse, Rhone, France*

A perfect example of the southern Rhône, filled with spiced black fruit jam and immensely, appealingly concentrated.

## *Valpolicella Ripasso, Arco dei Givi, Sartori, Veneto, Italy*

Ruby-red in colour tending to garnet with age; it offers a slightly ethereal perfume of red fruits with notes of vanilla. The flavour is fine, velvety and balanced, with good body and intensity.

## *Love by Leoube Rouge Organic, Chateau Leoube, Provence, France*

Very gourmet, it will seduce you with its notes of red berries. Smooth and slightly tannic, you will be surprised by the explosion of fruit on the palate which is completed by aromas of blond tobacco.

## *Reserve Pinot Noir, Rapaura Springs, Marlborough, New Zealand*

The Reserve Pinot Noir has delicious red berry flavours and a full, rich palate. Spicy oak and silky tannins combine for an elegant, lingering finish.

## *Love Grass Shiraz Organic, d'Arenberg, Barossa Valley, Australia*

Wild blackberries and raspberries complete with woody spice and brambly notes. Earthiness shines through, perhaps even a suggestion of leather and walnut. Tannins complete this generous and complex wine.

## *Rioja Crianza, Sierra Cantabria, Rioja, Spain*

From one of the greatest Rioja producers working today. Smooth, elegant Rioja, brimming with ripe cherries and other red fruit, the nose a sophisticated combination of spice, cocoa and a wisp of smoke.

## *Sonoma Cabernet Sauvignon, Louis Martini, California, USA*

Cabernet Sauvignon from California's renowned Napa Valley, almost jammy with black plums and blackcurrants and lightly spiced on the nose.

## *Chateauneuf-du-Pape Rouge, Domaine Chante Cigale, Rhone, France*

The ultimate Southern Rhone red, wonderful nose of spice and dark fruits followed by a rich, ripe palate with layers of fruit and spice.

## *Le Relais de Durfort-Vivens, Margaux, Bordeaux, France*

A timeless classic from the Lurton family once again. Dark colour, violet purple. Dark and red fruit aromas with mineral and woody notes. Very powerful and tannic although balanced and supple.



## ROSÉ WINE

### *Petit Rose, Ken Forrester, Western Cape, South Africa*

A fruit-forward blend of Grenache and Viognier grapes, awash with strawberries and cherries, with ripe raspberries on the finish and a waft of rose petal keeping everything fresh.

### *Comte de Provence.Rose, La Vidaubanaise, Provence, France*

Delightful, light pink Provençal rosé, awash with wild strawberries, lavender and rosemary: if sunshine had a flavour, it would be something like this.

### *Love by Leoube, Chateau Léoube, Provence, France*

This is a quintessential, dry Provence rosé style. Pale pink and with attractive fruit flavours of strawberry and white peach, it has fine overall balance. Drink anytime as an aperitif, or to accompany Mediterranean food.

### *Rose de Leoube Organic, Chateau Leoube, Provence, France*

There's a lovely freshness reminiscent of white fleshy fruit, that combines with the delicate red and dried fruits with a hint of spices. This is a drinkable and elegant style of rosé.

### *Whispering Angel, Chateau D'Esclans, Provence, France*

Pale pink in colour, it has flavours of redcurrant, dried flowers and spices on the nose, with a subtle herbal quality. Dry, with bitter red fruit flavours, it has a firm finish with lingering herbal notes.

### *Secret de Leoube Organic, Chateau Leoube, Provence, France*

Here's a "Secret" worth discovering! A rosé of power with an unusual dash of Cabernet Sauvignon giving this wine a wonderful structure and a warming mouthfeel. An elegant blend that pairs well with top quality meat, delicate fish dishes and Asian flavours.



## DESSERT WINE

*Sauternes-Barsac Half, Cypès de Climens, Bordeaux, France*

Barsac is one of the great French dessert wines and this fine example is wonderfully honeyed and perfumed with candied fruit, apricot and hints of vanilla.

*LBV Port 17 Quintado Crasto, Douro, Portugal*

Fine tannins form a trellis supporting wild blackberries and other wild fruit, while a waft of cacao supplies welcome savouriness and balance.

*Late Harvest Tokaji Katinka, Patricius, Tokaji, Hungary*

Lusciously sweet Hungarian wine, perfumed with caramel and vanilla, oranges and white chocolate, plus a scattering of spice.

## NON ALCOHOLIC

*NV Eins Zwei Zero Sparkling Rose, Pfalz, Germany*

Fresh with notes of strawberries, raspberry and slight hints of fresh grapefruit. The finish is dry and fairly long.

*Kisume Rose, Aubert & Matthieu, Languedoc-Roussillon, France*

Perfect for aperitifs, special events or just for fun, Kisumé Rose adds a contemporary note to your celebrations.

*Kisume Blanc, Aubert & Matthieu, Languedoc-Roussillon, France*

Enjoy the lightness of Kisumé, Blanc with refreshing bubbles, delicate aromas of tropical fruits, citrus fruits and white flower.
